Local Health Plans of California (LHPC) is a statewide trade association that represents all 17 of the community-based, not-for-profit health plans that provide access to critical and comprehensive healthcare services for lowincome populations enrolled in California's Medicaid program, Medi-Cal.

- Created by their counties, local plans are community-based & locally governed
- As mission-driven, not-for-profit organizations, local plans reinvest in their communities
- All plans are locally based operations with employees who live in the community
