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The Affordable Care Act (ACA) allowed states to expand Medicaid programs, making health care coverage possible for non-parents under 138% of the federal poverty level (FPL). Today, approximately 3.7 million Californians have health care coverage in Medi-Cal - California's Medicaid program – because of the Optional Expansion.
