ABOUT LOCAL PLANS

Local Health Plans of California (LHPC) is a statewide trade association that represents all 17 of the community-based, not-for-profit health plans that provide access to critical and comprehensive healthcare services for low-income populations enrolled in California's Medicaid program, Medi-Cal.

- Created by their counties, local plans are **community-based & locally governed**
- As mission-driven, not-for-profit organizations, local plans **reinvest in their communities**
- All plans are locally based operations with **employees who live in the community**
